Seibien is one of the few Oishi Bugaku style Japanese gardens remaining in the Tsugaru Region. There is a unique structure with a purely Japanese style first floor and a western style second floor called Seibikan located on the garden grounds. The building was used as a model for a Studio Ghibli movie and is located in a world of its own, away from the bustle of the city.
